Remark: *As AWC is monitoring quality of water discharge on monthly basis all operating prioperties, the incident was found at the newly open property (Melia Chaing Mai) that discharge quality exceeded legal limit, mainly BOD in August - December, 2022. Therefore we have developed plan to improve the efficiency of wastewater treatment plant and ensure that discharge water at all properties must be in line with legel requirement.
